Procedure

Registration Requirements:

Please check correct licence details are entered on MA-regonline.com. A licence audit of all competitors will take place up to one week in advance of the competition. Competitors will be unable to compete if they fail the licence audit check. If your Licence has expired, renew it immediately.

International Entries (by invitation only):

All participants must hold a valid licence and be part of a recognised group that is affiliated to World Taekwondo (WT). This membership must be proved by means of a valid certificate of membership at the time of registration. Please remember to bring this proof of membership to the tournament.

Please make entries on www.ma-regonline.com Please email your team list and entry fees can be paid by bank transfer (see below).

International entrants are responsible for arranging their own visas. Please contact us at competition@chungdokwan.org.uk if you require any documentation regarding this.

Entry Details (domestic competitors):

Entries must be made online at www.ma-regonline.com

Once you have registered your details, you must pay the entry fee by bank transfer and provide a list of competitors the payment relates to. Please email the completed list to competition@chungdokwan.org.uk We are not accepting entries by post.

Please make sure that your personal data is entered correctly online, otherwise the competitors will be rejected from the competition as a result of the licence audit.

Coaches:

Please note that ALL instructors wishing to coach their players register online at www.ma-regonline.com prior to the deadline on Friday 21st February 2025.

Only coaches that have pre-registered in this manner will be issued with passes (no new passes will be arranged at the event).

All coaches must be registered instructors with valid Instructor Indemnity Insurance. To prevent delays to the competition, we require clubs to have enough coaches for their competitors on the day.

NOTE:

- All entries must be received by Friday 21st February 2025.
- All entry fees must be with TCGB within 7 days of entering competitors otherwise the entrants will be excluded from the tournament.
- There will be no refunds for any withdrawals after Friday 21st February 2025.
- Should the event reach its competitor limit all entry fees will become immediately payable to allow for competitors from the waiting list to be added in case of any withdrawals.
- In order to comply with event regulations, these deadlines will be strictly enforced.

Weigh In

Weigh-In Schedule

Saturday 8th March 2025

(Main weigh-in at venue. An admin fee will be charged for any competitors needing to change weight category)

2:00pm – 6:00pm

Sunday 9th March 2025

(Back up weigh-in by request only - at venue. **Please note that no weight category changes will be permitted for competitors weighing in on the Sunday**)

7:00am – 8:30am

PLEASE NOTE

All players wishing to attend the weigh-in on Sunday must be in the queue by **8.00am at the latest**. Players who arrive after 8am will not be permitted to join the queue to weigh-in.

There will be a full weigh-in for all fighters. Please note, there will be no test weigh-in, the weigh in leeway is 0.1kg, if you fail your weigh in, you will either be disqualified with no claim to a refund or, on payment of an administrative fee of £20 (Saturday only), the entry will be transferred to the appropriate weight division.



Rules

World Taekwondo (WT) Full Contact rules will be followed except where explicitly stated otherwise. Full armour required; WT approved body armour, head guard, forearm guard, shin guard, hand gloves, groin guard and clear/white gum shield. Head guards must be red or blue. A list of companies which supply WT-recognised protective equipment can be found on the WT website: <http://www.worldtaekwondo.org/>

UK rules will be used where head kicks are permitted for all ages.

All competitors will be required to proceed to the inspection desk before entering the competition area. Any competitor wearing unofficial equipment will not be permitted to compete.

All competitors must hold a current licence.

Coaches must be over 18 and hold Instructor Professional Indemnity Insurance. In addition, they need to pre-register by the closing date to receive their pass to the competition area.

The decision of the judge is final.

NOTE

- All A Class athletes will be provided with a KPnP electronic body protector and headguard. All athletes should bring their own KPnP socks and all other PPE/equipment. All B Class Groups will be manual scoring.
- ALL ATHLETES MUST WEAR WORLD TAEKWONDO RECOGNISED UNIFORMS & PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

Rounds

All matches to be 3 x 2-minute rounds for Seniors & 1 ½ minute rounds for novices with a one-minute rest period between rounds

The organisers reserve the right to amend the round length according to entries received and time scales.
